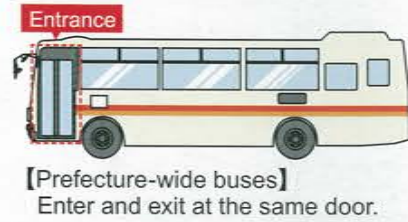
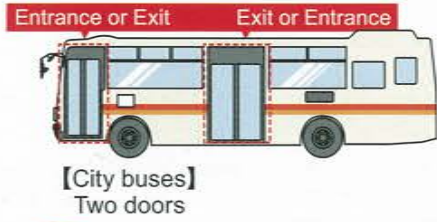


Bus Map Display

Bus routes and other information are displayed for all bus numbers.

① Bus number 80 is displayed only as 80

- ① Bus numbers
 - ② Bus destination and main routes
 - ③ Main bus routes (some routes not shown)
 - ④ Bus system numbers (sometimes not at this location)
- ※Displays vary somewhat depending on the bus company



Bus Stops and Timetables

Bus stop signs may differ according to the bus company operating along the route. This is a typical bus stop sign.



- ① Bus stop name
- ② Names of previous & next bus stops
- ③ Timetable
- ④ Bus service schedule

Types of Bus Stops

Bus stops are usually yellow or silver-colored (see pictures below) and come in many different styles.



How to Ride the Bus

Buses numbered 19 and under run short routes within Naha City. Those numbered 20 and up operate along other routes. There are two types of buses. ※Some rural buses are not numbered.

How to ride buses 1~6, 9, and 11~17

※The fare for these buses is a flat rate of 220 yen for adults and 110 yen for children under 12.

- ① Board at the front door.
- ② Place the fare in the fare box just after boarding.
- ③ Please press the button after your stop is called. ※However, your bus stop will be called in Japanese. Using the Bus Map, it is better if you tell the driver where to stop.
- ④ After the bus stops, leave your seat and exit by the rear door.

How to ride buses 7,8,10 and 20 or above

※Fares for these buses vary according to the distance traveled.

- ① Board at the front door. As for buses 7, 8 and 10, board at the rear door.
- ② Take a ticket from the dispenser next to the door.
- ③ Please press the button after your stop is called. ※However, your bus stop will be called in Japanese. Using the Bus Map, it is better if you tell the driver where to stop.
- ④ Check the fare corresponding to the amount displayed under the ticket number on the fare board.
- ⑤ After the bus stops, leave your seat and place the fare and ticket in the fare box.
- ⑥ Exit by the front door.

Bus Fare Ticket



Take a ticket when you board. Place it in the fare box along with the corresponding fare when exiting. Check the fare displayed under the ticket number on the fare board. Please pay the exact amount as the fare box does not dispense change.

Change Machine

Only 1,000 yen notes may be changed into 500 yen, 100 yen, 50 yen or 10 yen coins. Please remember that the fare box does not dispense change.

Raise your hand for the bus to stop

When you want to board a certain bus, it may pass on by unless you raise your hand to signal the bus to stop. Recently, more and more buses are stopping when there are people at the bus stop. However, if you are standing away from the bus stop or not looking in the direction of the approaching bus, the bus may not stop. Please remember to stand close to the bus stop.
